Members are encouraged to enter photographs monthly, one for each of the two categories. (**Open** and **Nature** categories will alternate each month and there will be a **Monthly Theme**). The images are reviewed by a judging committee and shown at the next meeting, with the judges' critiques. The photographer is not identified, *except* for the top entries. Entries are due by the 15th following the monthly meeting.

Submissions must be:

- in jpg or jpeg file format
- maximum of 1400 pixels horizontally
- maximum of 1050 pixels vertically
- 72-120 pixels per inch (PPI)
- file name should be in the format of Category-Photographer-Title.jpg
- sRGB color space
- entered via club website on or before the deadline

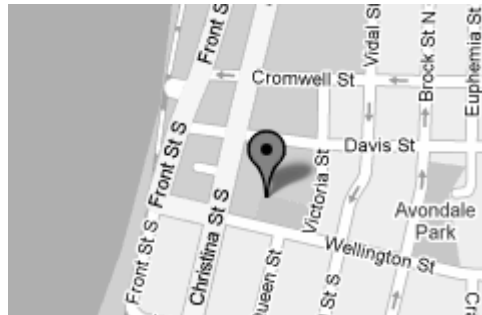
SARNIA PHOTOGRAPHIC CLUB
